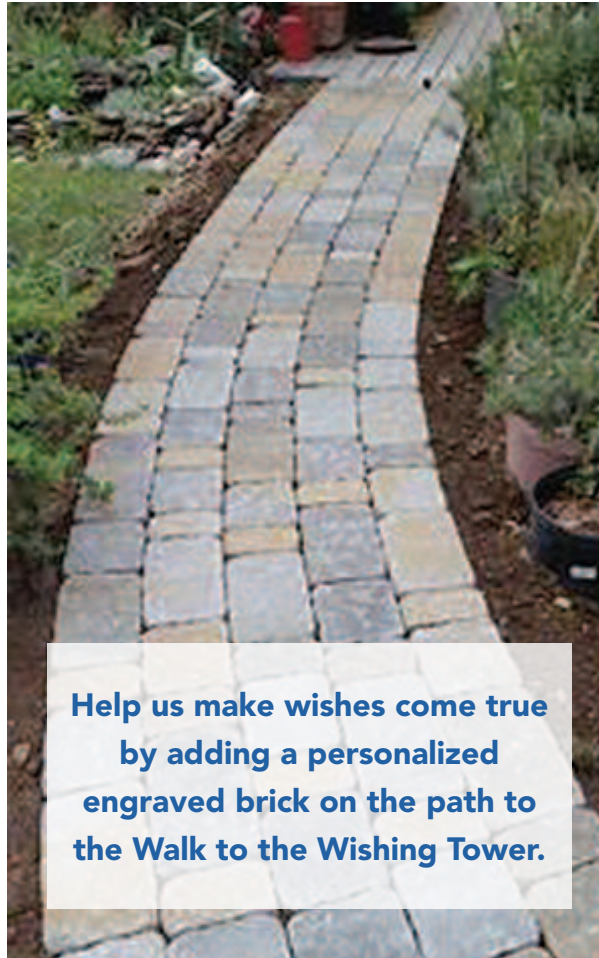

In early 2022, the concept design for the Wishing Tower was approved by the Brock Township Council and included in the framework for the Harbour Master Plan.
